

# CATALYST COMPLETION

BCEDC was excited to see the completion of a Catalyst Grant in 2022. The grant was written and awarded in 2021. **BCEDC** Director. Lisa Kremer, wrote the grant for the city of Independence and STAN Development. STAN Development is the home of The Brick Kitchen, Circle 8 Cyclery, and Allerton Brewing Company's brewing station. Jim Thompson with Iowa Economic **Development Authority** was able to stop by, evaluate, and close out the grant in the fall of 2022.





#### KEY BUSINESS GRANT

Balanced Nutrition of Fairbank was granted our very first Key Business Grant. This is a BCEDC developed and administered grant strictly for Buchanan County.



#### UPPER STORY HOUSING GRANT

BCEDC wrote and was awarded a \$600,000 Upper Story Grant for the City of Independence and the Hardware Hank building



#### **CHILDCARE**

BCEDC continues work with communities and industries on childcare initiatives and pursuing grant possibilities to further childcare opportunities within the county.



# HOUSING STUDY GRANT

BCEDC received grants from the USDA, MidAmerican Energy and the City of Independence to conduct a County Wide Housing Study to move development of housing forward within the County.



In 2022, BCEDC worked with the Small Business Development Center on ten potential new businesses to include Balanced Nutrition of Fairbank.







#### MANUFACTURING ROUNDTABLE

BCEDC worked on connecting area manufacturers through a Manufacturing Roundtable in conjunction with The Innovation Lab and CoWork591. Partnering with The Innovation Lab, future events will be held due to the success and community built during initial events.

Partnering with Hawkeye Community College, we hosted our largest Leadership Program to date. 

#### **SOCIAL MEDIA & MARKETING**

In 2022, we completed a marketing study with McConville Consulting and a 5-year strategic plan with Peerman Group. An action plan was developed based on the results.

We redesigned our social media strategies to best fit Buchanan County and its communities, businesses and industries. In doing so, we highlighted each of our eleven communities throughout the year and created a blog to highlight key topics throughout the county.

A plan was created to better promote the opportunities we provide Buchanan County such as our Revolving Loan Fund and Key Business Grant. In addition, we were able to connect businesses not only through visits but through email, newsletters and social media to keep them up to date on all initiatives available including grants, classes, and other opportunities.
